Rosters can be changed any time before your first game, so enter and then recruit a team!

## Rules and Regulations

- Games up to fifteen (15) points for Divisions 1 thru 4; Games up to twenty (20) points for Divisions 5 thru 10
- If game lasts 30 minutes, official will halt play, then resume for one (1) minute to conclude game
- Tournament officials reserve the right to reduce the length of a game, if necessary
- One minute half-time at seven (7) points for Divisions 1 thru 4 and at ten (10) points for Divisions 5 thru 10
- Two (2) 30 second timeouts per game
- Coin flip to determine initial possession
- Ball taken on top after each made basket and dead ball situation. Defense checks the ball and the ball must be pass in from out of bounds. This is not a violation, just a do-over.
- The ball must be taken back with both feet behind the arc on all possession changes before advancing
- Baskets count one (1) point and baskets behind the arc count two (2)
- On the seventh team foul, offended team gets one (1) free throw. If the free throw is missed, they keep possession. If the free-throw is made, the other team gets the ball
- A free throw will be shot on all shooting fouls. If there is a made basket and a foul, the ball changes possession, but a team foul is assessed
- Three-second violations in the lane will be assessed
- No dunking!!
- No profanity, taunting, fighting or other unsportsmanlike conduct
- Officials have the authority to eject players and spectators from the game
- Organizers, sponsors, volunteers and others involved accept no liability for injury. Players play at their own risk. This is not a school function.
- Tiebreakers will be head-to-head results.
